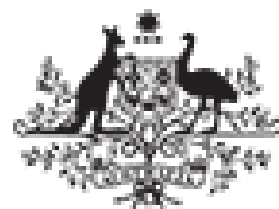

#### Food Recall

A new Australian consumer level food recall has been published on the FSANZ website:

**Entyce Food Ingredients Pty Ltd** is conducting a precautionary recall of the above product. The product has been available for sale at IGA, Foodworks, Foodland, SPAR, Supabarn and other independent retailers via Metcash distribution nationally.

**Problem:** The recall is due to potential Hepatitis A virus contamination.
